Pageant: Dragon and Jester episode 7.

Henry Woolmer Stubbings (1888-1916) and James Douglas Stubbings (1889-1984), sons of James Woolmer Stubbings (1864-1944), bootmaker, Cheap Street, and Vivas Jane Stubbings (née Sims) (1858-1938), teacher of Music (pianist) at the Ladies College (now Sherborne Girls' School).

Jester (episode 7): Henry Woolmer Stubbings (1888-1916). Joined 2nd Dorset Regiment and died in Mesopotamia on 27 August 1916. He is named on Sherborne town war memorial.



Dragon (episode 7): signed 'D. Stubbings', most likely James Douglas Stubbings (1889-1984) and probably went by his second name of Douglas.
