

James Woolmer Stubbings (1864-1944)

James Woolmer Stubbings (1864-1944) was a boot maker in Cheap Street, Sherborne. He married Vivas Jane Sims (1858-1938), a teacher of music (pianist) at the Ladies College (now Sherborne Girls' School). In 1911 the family were living at 3 Sunnyside Terrace, North Road, Sherborne.



Father of Henry Woolmer Stubbings (1888-1916) who played the jester in episode 7 of the Pageant and James Douglas Stubbings (1889-1984) who is believed to have played the dragon in episode 7 of the Pageant.
