



Memorial Inscriptions (in alphabetical order) at St Mary Magdalene, Castleton, Sherborne - REVISITED in 2020 (updated 2025)

In 1975 Sir Mervyn T Medlycott Bt. F.S., of Sandford Orcas, transcribed and then had typed into a list the Memorial Inscriptions at Castleton Church. If any inscription could not be deciphered, he checked further - see the following. Three copies of the findings were produced and distributed. One copy each to the S&DFHS, the Dorset Records Office (Now the Dorset History Centre) and the Society of Genealogists.

NOTE from Sir Mervyn Medlycott: In the autumn of 1884 Richard Kinneir* MD of Sherborne listed all the tombstones in Castleton both inside and outside the church. [MSS book now kept by Sherborne Museum]. This list has been checked against those listed in *"The History of Dorset"* by John Hutchins 3rd. Edition 1870, and those given in a MSS notebook entitled *"Ye Olde Mortality, Dorset"* compiled by Arthur W. Matthews [c.1900], which is in the library of the Society of Genealogists Acc. No.519.

Sir Mervyn Medlycott (1947-2021)



*Richard Kenneir MD Edinburgh retired to Sherborne with his wife in around 1870. They lived at Bracondale in Long Street (mentioned in *A History of Long Street, Sherborne* by Susan and Ray Penn). Dr Kenneir died in April 1892 and his wife in September 1892 and they are both buried in Sherborne Cemetery. He was an amateur historian and his notebook of the MI's of Sherborne (made in 1884) is in Sherborne Museum.


Ann Smith, Archivist Sherborne Castle Estates, remembers: *'Mervyn must have put in hours and hours of painstaking work transcribing the MIs. He went all over the place to do them, both in Somerset and Dorset. Lady Gass talks about him going over to Stogursey to do theirs, which is miles away. Arthur and Murial Monk did quite a few, but I think Mervyn did the bulk. Well done for re-typing them. It must be quite a daunting task, but well worth having them on computer.'*

MONUMENTS DESTROYED between 1884 and 1975 - in Blue.

One headstone, not located by Sir Mervyn, was recorded by Hutchins but not by Kinneir and is listed - in Brown.

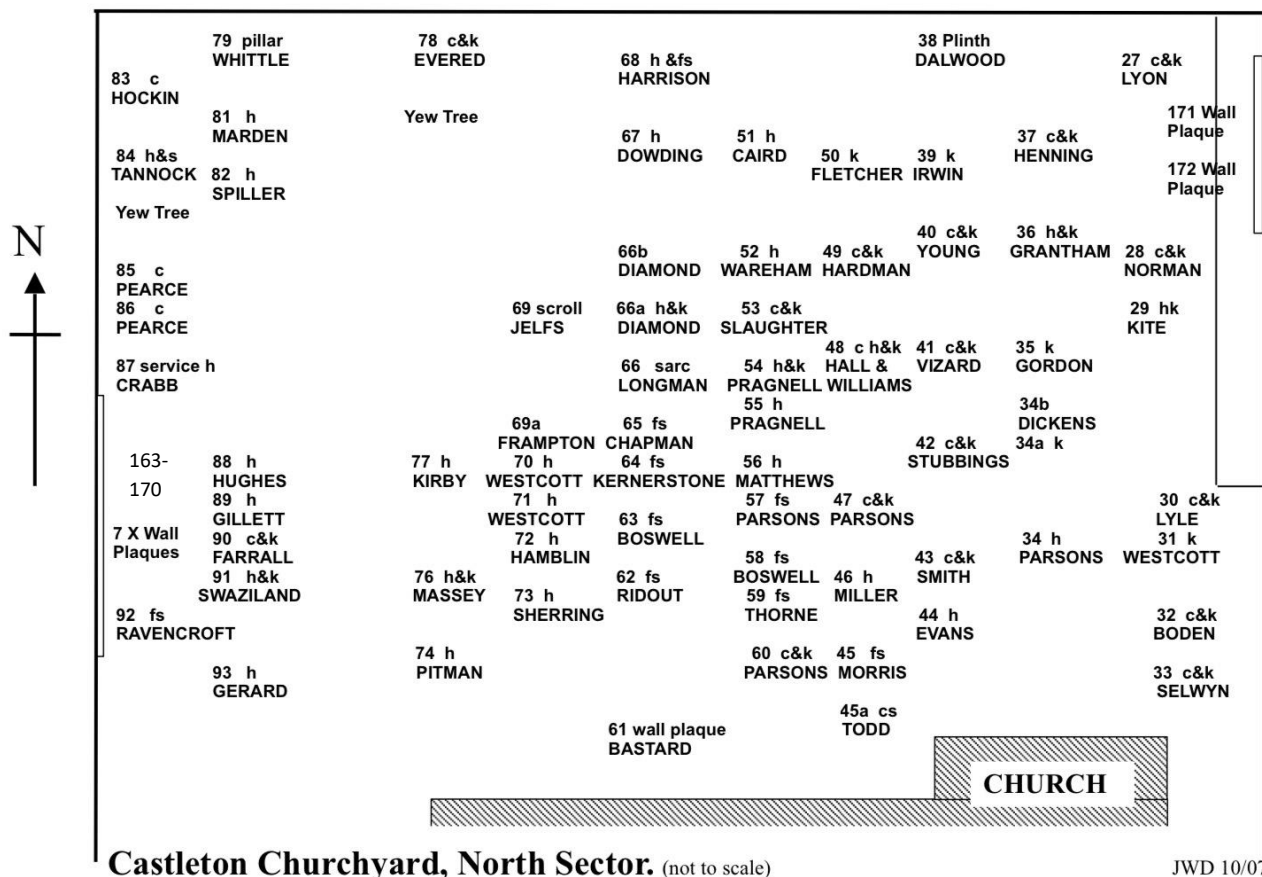

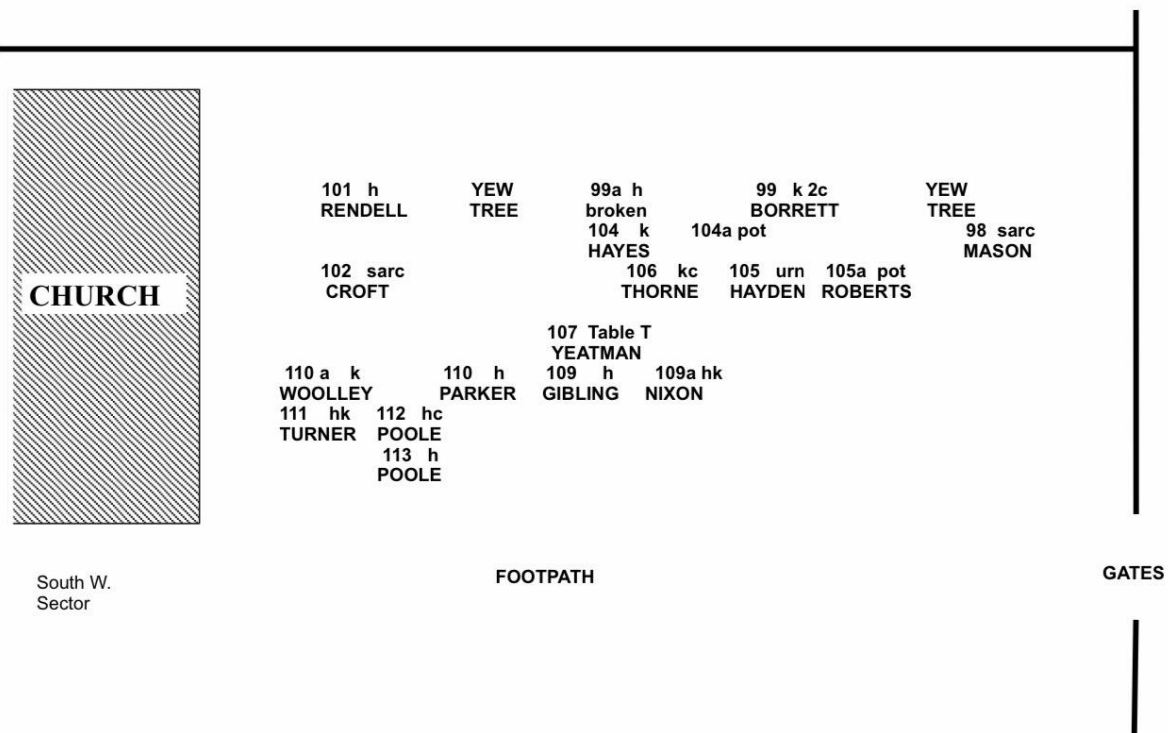

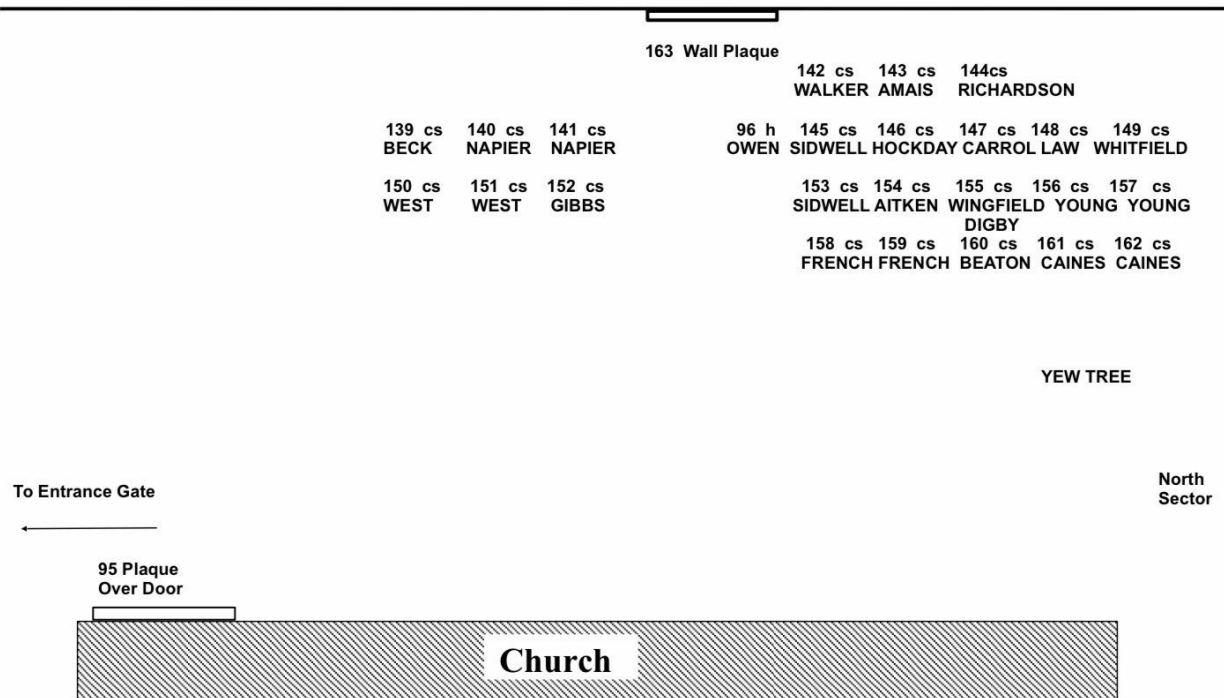
